## **WAGE INCREASES EFFECTIVE FROM 1 JULY 2013**

Wage increases for the Fast Food Industry Award 2010 arising from the Annual Wage Review by the Full Bench of the Fair Work Commission and effective from the first full pay period on or after 1 July 2013.

The Full Bench increased the weekly wages by 2.6% for employees whose work is covered by this award.

These increases can be absorbed into over award payments.

Level 1	\$683.40
Level 2	\$724.50
Level 3 - in charge of one or no persons - in charge of two or more persons	\$735.70 \$744.60

## Schedule A — Classifications

#### A.1 Fast Food Employee Level 1

- A.1.1 An employee engaged in the preparation, the receipt of orders, cooking, sale, serving or delivery of meals, snacks and/or beverages which are sold to the public primarily to take away or in food courts in shopping centres.
- A.1.2 A Fast Food Employee Level 1 will undertake duties as directed within the limits of their competence, skills and training including incidental cleaning and cleaning of toilets.

#### A.2 Fast Food Employee Level 2

An employee who has the major responsibility on a day to day basis for supervising Fast Food employees Level 1 and/or training new employees or an employee required to exercise trade skills.

#### A.3 Fast Food Employee Level 3

An employee appointed by the employer to be in charge of a shop, food outlet, or delivery outlet.
